# GOD'S WISDOM FOR LIFE, PART 10: "WISDOM IS CALLING"

Proverbs 8:1-36

Listen to Wisdom's call to find life in the Lord's favor.

## I. Wisdom's call is for those lacking wisdom (1-5)

<sup>1</sup> Does not wisdom call? Does not understanding raise her voice? <sup>2</sup> On the heights beside the way, at the crossroads she takes her stand; <sup>3</sup> beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries aloud:

<sup>4</sup> "To you, O men, I call, and my cry is to the children of man.

<sup>5</sup>O simple ones, learn prudence; O fools, learn sense.

#### II. Wisdom's words are all true and much better (6-11)

<sup>6</sup> Hear, for I will speak noble things, and from my lips will come what is right, <sup>7</sup> for my mouth will utter truth; wickedness is an abomination to my lips. <sup>8</sup> All the words of my mouth are righteous; there is nothing twisted or crooked in them. <sup>9</sup> They are all straight to him who understands, and right to those who find knowledge. <sup>10</sup> Take my instruction instead of silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold, <sup>11</sup> for wisdom is better than jewels, and all that you may desire cannot compare with her.

## III. Wisdom's sense is clear between good and evil (12-21)

<sup>12</sup> "I, wisdom, dwell with prudence, and I find knowledge and discretion. <sup>13</sup> The fear of the Lord is hatred of evil. Pride and arrogance and the way of evil and perverted speech I hate. <sup>14</sup> I have counsel and sound wisdom; I have insight; I have

strength. <sup>15</sup> By me kings reign, and rulers decree what is just; <sup>16</sup> by me princes rule, and nobles, all who govern justly. <sup>17</sup> I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently find me. <sup>18</sup> Riches and honor are with me, enduring wealth and righteousness. <sup>19</sup> My fruit is better than gold, even fine gold, and my yield than choice silver. <sup>20</sup> I walk in the way of righteousness, in the paths of justice, <sup>21</sup> granting an inheritance to those who love me, and filling their treasuries. he does not know that it will cost him his life.

#### IV. Wisdom's delight is in the Creator's works (22-31)

<sup>6</sup> My son, keep my words and treasure up my commandments with you;

<sup>2</sup> keep my commandments and live; keep my teaching as the apple of your eye;

<sup>3</sup> bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart.

<sup>4</sup> Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call insight your intimate friend,

<sup>5</sup> to keep you from the forbidden woman, from the adulteress with her smooth words.

# V. Wisdom's promise is a blessed life in the Lord's favor (32-36)

<sup>32</sup> "And now, O sons, listen to me: blessed are those who keep my ways. <sup>33</sup> Hear instruction and be wise, and do not neglect it. <sup>34</sup> Blessed is the one who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting beside my doors. <sup>35</sup> For whoever finds me finds life and obtains favor from the Lord, <sup>36</sup> but he who fails to find me injures himself; all who hate me love death."
